JOB SUMMARY

Fayette County Public Health (FCPH) is seeking a Public Health Nurse or Paramedic to report to Fayette County Jail. This position is full time and 30-40 hours per week. The Public Health Nurse or Paramedic will report for work at the Fayette County Jail and is responsible for jail nursing services and other assigned Health Department Duties as requested. This position is funded through local contracts and board of health, and offers competitive salary and benefits.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The Public Health Nurse or Paramedic is responsible for all essential functions.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

This job requires an active Nursing License from the State of Ohio or an active Ohio Emergency Medical Services Paramedic Certificate, a valid Ohio Driver's License, and an active CPR Certification. Specialized skills such as typing, computer skills, and strong communication skills (both oral and written) are required. Experience in public health or a school clinic setting highly preferred.
